Call for Applications Kunststiftung Ingvild und Stephan Goetz's Media Art Award for the Promotion of Young Artists

The Sammlung Goetz is an internationally renowned contemporary art collection with its own exhibition building in Munich. Founded in 1993, it now contains more than 5000 works from nearly all artistic genres, including media art, a more recent focus represented with videos, slide projections, extensive multi-channel projections and room-sized installations.

The Sammlung Goetz strives not only to exhibit and preserve its holdings, but to grow these. One focus is the latest trends in contemporary art. With the goal of promoting young artists in the field of media art and supporting the creation of new works and strengthening their public perception, the Kunststiftung Ingvild und Stephan Goetz—in cooperation with Munich's Academy of Fine Arts and the Sammlung Goetz—has established a new media art award to promote young artists. Endowed with 5,000 euros, the award allows the recipient to realize an artwork and exhibit it in the art academy's gallery.

The prize is open to young students of the Munich art academy who will complete their studies within the next six months or who have done so within the last two years. The application should include a short concept statement for a media artwork yet to be realized (films, videos and installations are permitted), supplemented by a comprehensive portfolio of the applicant's artistic career to date.

The following must be submitted:

- illustrative project description (no more than two manuscript pages)
- cost calculation
- time plan for the work's execution
- curriculum vitae and portfolio or links to image and film material of realized works

The jury—made up of staff members of the Sammlung Goetz, the Academy of Fine Arts Munich and the Kunststiftung Ingvild und Stephan Goetz as well as external art experts—will select the prize recipient. The work must be completed within six months and will then become part of the Kunststiftung Ingvild und Stephan Goetz.

The Media Art Prize, endowed with 5,000 euros, is a cooperation between the Sammlung Goetz, the Academy of Fine Arts Munich and the Kunststiftung Ingvild und Stephan Goetz. The prize is to be awarded annually for an initial period of three years and bestowed on younger artists active in the field of media art; its goal is to promote the production of new artworks and to strengthen their public perception.
