In the show you will discover many new forms, which, as objects, project from the wall or appropriate the exhibition space. Immerse yourself in the diverse world of female artists and the materials they employ and become inspired to create your own art object! Whether working with plasticine, Styrofoam, wood, paper, cotton wool or nylon stockings, your imagination will know no bounds when it comes to designing and creating objects in the workshop!
